6. Research

One of the strong points of the department has been its eminence in research. In recognition of the research outcome, the department has been awarded Special Assistance Programme (SAP-DRS) of UGC since 2002.

Research Areas:

- Analytic Philosophy
- Ethics traditional and applied
- Value Education
- Continental and Postmodern Philosophy
- Philosophy of Religion

Research Students:

- About 100 PhD dissertations have been supervised by the teachers of the department.
- At present there are about 50 registered Ph.D. scholars, 8 M. Phil. students and 10 course work students in the Department.
- About 85 M. Phil. students have completed their dissertations over the years.
