We have a rich Manuscripts Museum with near about 900 nos. manuscripts in Sanskrit and Bengali both Languages in the Department of Bengali. More than four hundred Manuscripts in Sanskrit Language and the subject-matters of those manuscripts are worship system of various God and Goddess, Nyaysastra, Grammer(Kalap Byakaran etc.), Kabya, Bhagabat Abhidhan and so on. In Bengali Language Manuscripts there subjectmatters are Mangalkabya (Manasamangal- Chandimangal- Dharmamangal, etc.), Mahabharat, SristiPuran, Chaitanyacharitamrita, SrikrisnaPremtarangini, Devimangal, Smaranmangal, Chaitanyamangal, Srikrisnamangal, satyanarayaner Gourangacharitra, Kalika Puja Paddhati, Durga Puja Paddhati and so on. These manuscripts are collected by Departmental teachers and Ex-students from the different place of North Bengal, specially, Malda, Coochbehar, Paschim Dinajpur, Jalpaiguri. All Manuscripts have so nicely been preserved in the Almirah / Stack in the Puthisala. Interested teachers and students try to read manuscripts and know the Indian vis-à-vis Bengalee Heritage and Tradition. Manuscripts Reading is included in the Syllabus of Medieval Bengali Literature.

These Manuscripts have been written on the basis of socio-cultural and religious background. On the other hand those Manuscripts are one of the historical part of this region.
