NOTICE

The undersigned is directed to notify informing all concerned that –

- i) The University has decided to conduct U.G. Law Even Semesters' (Regular/Casual/Supplementary) and Odd Semesters' Supplementary Examinations, 2020 from **7th December, 2020** onwards. Due to Covid-19 pandemic the conventional mode of Examinations, i.e. writing examinations in the examination hall in pen and paper mode has been replaced by blended modes of both examination and assignment. The detailed schedules for the aforesaid examinations shall be published shortly at www.nbu.ac.in and www.nbuexams.net .
- ii) The students will be given question papers to write answers and prepare assignments at home only. The question papers shall be available at www.nbuexams.net before examinations. Besides the Head, Department of Law, NBU and the Principals of Jalpaiguri Law College and ILS shall also be provided with question papers before examinations.
- iii) The Examination will be 50% in Assignment mode and 50% in Examination mode.

Examination Mode (for both CBCS and Non CBCS):

While examination mode is concerned, there shall be 4 short questions, each carrying 5 marks (4 x 5 marks = 20) and 3 broad questions, each carrying 10 marks (3 x 10 marks = 30). The duration of each paper/subject is 2 hours. The students will be given 30 minutes' time for downloading question paper from the above website and uploading the written answer scripts online/submitted the written answer scripts offline.

The Department of Law, NBU and the respective Law Colleges shall conduct Practical Examinations of their students.

Assignment Mode (for CBCS only):

The students under CBCS mode shall have to prepare two assignments, each carrying 25 marks (2 x 25 marks = 50).

Assignment Mode (for Non CBCS only):

The students under Non CBCS mode shall have to prepare only one assignment for 30 marks apart from the existing internal assessment of 20 marks (30 + 20 = 50 marks).

- (iv) The question papers for assignments shall be available on **25/11/2020 (2:00 pm)** and the students shall submit all assignments together on or before **02/12/2020** online/offline to the Department of Law, NBU (for NBU students only) and their respective Law Colleges (for Jalpaiguri Law College and ILS students).
- (v) The students shall enroll themselves for the aforesaid examinations from **04/11/2020** to **10/11/2020** online at www.nbuexams.net . They shall download their admit cards from **18/11/2020 (2:00 pm onwards)**.

(vi) The students may opt for online or offline mode of submission of written answer scripts and assignments. The students opting for online mode shall download the first page of the answer script of the University examinations from www.nbuexams.net and upload the answer scripts/assignments writing in A4 size papers along with downloaded first page of the University answer script filled with Roll Nos., Registration Nos., Subject, Papers etc. to the Email-IDs of the Department of Law, NBU (for NBU students only) and their respective Law Colleges (for Jalpaiguri Law College and IILS students).

(vii) Students opting for offline mode shall collect the blank answer scripts from any of the nearest Colleges affiliated to the University of North Bengal, Department of Law, NBU or the Examination Branch, NBU from **23/11/2020** to **25/11/2020** through parents/guardians or any authorized person on production of Admit Card and original University Registration Certificate and submit their written answer scripts / assignments through parents/guardians or any authorized person to the Department of Law, NBU (for NBU students only) and their respective Law Colleges (for Jalpaiguri Law College and IILS students) as per schedule.

(viii) The students opting for offline mode may also download the first page of the answer script of the University Examinations from the above website and submit their answer scripts / assignments writing in A4 size papers offline to the Department of Law, NBU (for NBU students only) and their respective Law colleges (for Jalpaiguri Law College and IILS students) as per schedule.
