

Lokesh Ohri is an Anthropologist, author and activist. His work is focused on the Himalayas. He has a doctorate from the South Asia Institute, University of Heidelberg, Germany. He was also Marsilius Van Inghen Fellow at the Radboud University Nijmegen, Netherlands. He has worked extensively on the Ganga and published a two volume compendium titled *Upper Ganga Region:* Cultural Resource Mapping. His latest work, Till Kingdom Come, published in India by Permanent Black and worldwide by the State University of New York Press (SUNY), deals with the Himalayan divine-king Mahasu, and how rituals define political life in the Himalayas. He also runs a popular heritage walking group called Been There Doon That? in Dehradun, and heads INTACH in Uttarakhand.
