General Guidelines for Participation

- 1. Students and Research Scholars of the University of North Bengal can participate in the competitions. (Main Campus, Jalpaiguri Campus, and DDE)
- 2. Registration through Google Form Link: https://forms.gle/wDGxMnboXXzbNthz8
- 3. For group events only ONE representative shall fill the form on behalf of the whole group.
- 4. Last Date of Registration: May 15, 2023
- 5. Decorum of the event should be maintained
- 6. Judge's decision shall be final
- 7. Coordinators shall have the final authority to change rules/ timings/venue in case of any problems prior to the event.

Group Dance Competition Organised by Rhythmic Club

Guidelines for participation:

- 1. Select any one song from the following, for the performance
 - a: এবার তোর মরা গাঙে বান এসেছে
 - b: মন মোর মেঘের সঙ্গী
 - c: খরবায়ু বয় বেগে, চারি দিক ছায় মেঘে
- 2. Students and Research Scholars shall participate in groups.
- 3. Minimum 2 and Maximum 5 participants in a group
- 4. Maximum 2 groups from each Department/Center
- 5. Maximum duration: 6 minutes
- 6. Props can be used in the performance (own arrangements)
- 7. The music track should be carried by the group to the venue of the competition

Group Song Competition Organised by Rhythmic Club

Guidelines for participation:

- 1. Select any one song from the following, for the performance
 - a: আমার মুক্তি আলোয় আলোয় এই আকাশে
 - b: আকাশভরা সূর্য-তারা, বিশ্বভরা প্রাণ
 - c: সকাতরে ওই কাঁদিছে সকলে শোনো শোনো পিতা
- 2. Students and Research Scholars shall participate in groups.
- 3. Minimum 2 and Maximum 5 participants in a group
- 4. Maximum 2 groups from each Department/Center
- 5. Maximum duration: 6 minutes
- **6.** The organizing committee shall provide synthesizer and tabla
- **7.** Use of other musical instruments is strictly prohibited.
- **8.** Groups are requested to coordinate with the musicians arranged by the organising committee prior to their respective performances

Individual Painting Competition Organised by Arts and Crafts Club

Guidelines for participation:

- 1. Select any one theme from the following
 - a. ফুল বলে, ধন্য আমি (The flower says, I'm honored)
 - b. গ্রামছাড়া ওই রাঙা মাটির পথ (The crimson earthen road adjacent to the village)
 - c. রাত্রি এসে যেথায় মেশে দিনের পারাবারে (Where the night touches the edge of the day)
- 2. Size of the painting should be 18X12 inches.
- 3. The painting should be done on paper. Choice of the paper as per the participants.
- 4. Medium of the painting as per the choice of the participants.
- 5. Students and Research Scholars can participate individually.
- 6. Name of the participant, Department/Center, Theme, Status (PG Student / Research Scholar) and contact number (preferably WhatsApp) should be mentioned on the back side of the Painting.
- 7. It should be remembered that this is NOT a poster-making competition, it is a Painting competition.
- 8. Date of submission in hardcopy: May 15, 2023, by 5 pm at CSLLC Office, NBU

Individual Extempore Competition Organised by Debating Club

Guidelines for participation:

- 1. Students and Research Scholars can participate individually
- 2. Maximum 2 participants from each Department/Center
- 3. Topics related to Rabindranath Tagore's life, works, ideologies, etc will be given on the spot. No request for a change of topic shall be entertained
- 4. 4 minutes time would be given out of which 3 minutes will be for speaking
- 5. Medium of speech will be in English/ Bengali / Hindi / Nepali
- 6. Participants will not be allowed to take any paper or material with him/her during the speech

Individual Essay Writing Competition Organised by Writer's Club

Guidelines for participation:

1. The topic for writing essay:

- 4. The length of essay should not exceed 1000 words.
- 5. Only one submission per person will be accepted
- 6. Essay should be sent to aikatan@nbu.ac.in
- 7. Files must be in pdf format as an attachment with the email
- 8. The font size should be 12 with 1.5 line spacing
- 9. Please ensure to rename the file using the participant's "First name_last name."
- 10. Name of the Participant, Department/Center, Status (PG Student / Research Scholar) and contact number (preferably WhatsApp) should be mentioned both in the body of the email and the pdf attachment
- 11. Deadline for submission: May 14, 2023
