

Notification for P.G. (M.A./M.Sc.) & U.G. (B.A./B.Com.) First Semester Examinations,
2021 for the Academic Session 2020-2021
(Under Distance Education Mode)

The undersigned is directed to notify informing all concerned that -

1. **The P.G. (M.A. / M.Sc.) and U.G. (B.A./B.Com.) First Semester Examinations, 2021** for the students of 2020-2021 (November-December) Academic Session admitted during **January, 2021 to February, 2021** shall commence from **27.09.2021**. The mode of Examinations shall be Assignment based
2. The students of 2020-2021 (July-August) Academic Session admitted during **September 2020 to December, 2020** those who are not able to sit the First Semester Examinations on July, 2021 may also sit the examinations commence from **27.09.2021**.
3. The Question papers shall be available at www.nbuexams.net from **27.09.2021 (12 noon)**. The candidates may submit written assignments either offline at **DE Cell, Examination Branch, NBU** maintaining all protocol of COVID-19 Pandemic situation or may submit online by mailing the written assignments (PDF format) to the respective Email IDs mentioned in the Admit Cards within **04.10.2021 to 05.10.2021**.
4. The candidates are to fill in the Examination forms and download the Admit Cards from www.nbuexams.net from **21/09/2021 at 12:00 noon onwards**.
5. The students opting for online mode shall download the first page of the answer script of the University examinations from www.nbuexams.net and upload the written answer scripts writing in A4 size papers along with downloaded first page of the answer script filled with Roll Nos., Registration Nos., Subject, Papers etc. to the respective Email-IDs mentioned in the Admit Cards.
6. Students opting for offline mode shall collect the blank answer scripts from the **DE Cell, Examinations Branch, NBU** from **24/09/2021 to 26/09/2021** on production of Admit Card, Identity Card and University Registration Certificate.
7. The students opting for offline mode may also download the first page of the answer script of the University Examinations from the above website and submit the written answer scripts to the **DE Cell, Examinations Branch, NBU** attaching the downloaded first page of the answer script filled with Roll Nos., Registration Nos., Subject, Papers etc.
8. The students opting out the prescribed mode of examinations for reasons whatsoever shall inform the Controller of Examinations in writing within **26/09/2021 (12 Noon)**. A special examination will be conducted by the university for such students as and when normalcy will restore.
